

KIN has reached a new milestone, generating record-breaking funds from generous donors!
Since our founding in 2014, we are thrilled to continue spreading the KIN movement across the United States.



22 family participants were involved in lessons taught at healthcare clinics.

#### **PROJECTS DETAILS OUTCOMES** Teams of 5 volunteers visit local KIN delivered education to 1,359 elementary students across 64 Education elementary classrooms to teach classrooms.
